How and when do exchange/study abroad students register for classes?

A week prior to the start of the classes



How will students get from housing to class?

Students living on campus housing can go on foot to classes. Others living outside campus will use public transportation, which is free for students who request a student transportation card.



What is the international office assisting students with?

The international office registers the students at the university, briefs the students on administrative procedures after arrival and assigns UnB students to help international students get used to the university.



Do students have access to exercise/sports facilities?

There are sports courses and a School of Physical Education that provides some exercise and sports activities.
