*5 The module "Social Work Theories and Methods" lasts for two semesters and the 7th semester unit is based on the 6th semester units in terms of contents. Therefore, the following rules apply: *Within one semester*, exchange students can only attend units from the 6th semester (unit 1 and/or unit 2, part I). Attending units from the 6th and the 7th semester at the same time is not possible. Unit 2, part II is not open to exchange students – with two exceptions. Exception 1: Students stay at ASH Berlin for two semesters and attended unit 2, part I during the first semester. Exception 2: In case both parts of unit 2 are offered in English, students can attend both parts within one or two semesters. This exception is made to provide more course options to English-speaking students. You can find more information concerning the English course offer in our FAQ, question 1 on the last page.

While all units listed here will be offered in German, approx. 12-15 units will also be offered in English, Turkish or Spanish (called "International Curriculum"). They will be published in the course catalogue "LSF" online at www.ash-berlin.eu/Sf about 3-4 weeks before the start of the semester. In order to get a rough idea of what will be offered and in order to prepare your Learning Agreement, you should access the International Curriculum from past semesters at www.ash-berlin.eu/sh-international/exchange-at-ash-berlin/#c7405. For example, our module "Diversity Studies" in the third semester consists of two units: unit 1 "Racism and Migration" and unit 2 "Gender and Queer Studies".
