Records	the international office of the home university.



Semester fees	Enrolment takes place after arrival in Mainz on the induction day.
	All students (German and international) are required to pay a semester fee, which is approximately 370 EUR.
	The semester fee is a contribution to cover the costs for services such as the semester ticket that is covering the free use of public transport in the Rhine-Main region throughout the semester. This is <u>not</u> a tuition fee. Exchange students pay regular tuition fees to their home institution as appropriate. There is no tuition fee at CUAS Mainz.

Costs of living	The average budget for living and studying in Mainz is about 850 EUR per month . However, the actual costs of living depend on the personal expenses of each student.

Visa information	All exchange students are required to inquire in advance whether they need a visa to study in Germany or not. Information on visa requirements can be found here . If a visa is required, the student should calculate at least 8 - 10 weeks' time to apply for it.



Residence permit	All incoming exchange students must register with the local
	Immigration Office within two weeks after entering Germany in
	order to obtain their residence permit.
Health insurance	Every student in Germany must have health insurance, including exchange students. As soon as you are admitted, please notify your health insurance company by stating our university number 52733425 or alternatively the number H0002422 that you will be enrolled at CUAS Mainz from 01.03. (summer semester) or from 01.09. (winter semester).
	Please note that a valid health insurance plan is mandatory for your visa/residence permit.
