GERMAN LANGUAGE COURSES

German as a Foreign Language – Courses for Erasmus and other exchange students

The University's Language Learning Institute (SLI) offers the following courses in German as a Foreign Language:

The tuition fee for the Intensive German Course is **300€ per semester**.

1	Intensive German Course including additional courses	A1 (beginners) to C1 (advanced)	Weekdays daily 8.15 – 11.45 (13:30)	3 x 5 = 15 CPs

You will take a placement test before beginning the course. This will indicate your level of proficiency in German, and you will be allocated to a course accordingly.

German for special purposes (DSH2 upward)

German for Economics
German for Science and Engineering
German for Humanities and Social Sciences
German for Politics and History

The courses are offered every second term, 2 hours per week, with a total of 24 hours. The course fee is 10€.

German in the Evening

Levels: A1, A2, B1 and B1+

The courses are offered twice a week in the evening (6 pm to 9 pm) with a total of 100 hours. The course fee is 20€. You will take a placement test before beginning this course.
