

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
ON ACADEMIC AND RESEARCH COOPERATION BETWEEN
UNIVERSIDAD NACIONAL DE COLOMBIA, BOGOTA,
COLOMBIA

AND
INTERNATIONAL IT POLICY PROGRAM (ITPP), SEOUL NATIONAL
UNIVERSITY, REPUBLIC OF KOREA

The professor IGNACIO MANTILLA PRADA, named RECTOR by means of Resolution No 016 of 2015 and Possession Certificate No. 001 of 2015, acting according to articles 15^o of the Agreement 011 of 2005, article 13 of Decree 1210 of 1993 and the article 3 of the Agreements and Contracts Manual adopted by Resolution of Rectory No 1551 of 2014, in name and representation of the UNIVERSIDAD NACIONAL DE COLOMBIA, here and after referred to as Universidad Nacional de Colombia autonomous entity of the Colombian state, attached to the Ministry of National Education of Colombia, governed at the moment by Decree 1210 of 1993, with address in Carrera 45 No 26 – 85 Edificio Uriel Gutiérrez in the city of Bogotá D. C. – Colombia, on one hand. And by the other the professor JUNSEOK HWANG in name and representation of the INTERNATIONAL IT POLICY PROGRAM – ITPP OF SEOUL NATIONAL UNIVERSITY – SOUTH KOREA, hereinafter referred to as ITPP, considering their common interest in promoting the mutual cooperation in the area of education and research, both parties, therefore, wish to expand the basis for friendship and cooperative educational exchange, and have set forth the following Memorandum of Understanding (MOU):

Article I: Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to develop academic and educational cooperation on the basis of equality and reciprocity and to promote relations and mutual understanding between both universities.

Article II: Scope of the Cooperation

Both parties undertake to promote and develop academic cooperation as follows:

1. Exchange of academic and administrative staff and students.
2. Cooperation in research and the presentation of its results.
3. Exchange of academic materials, publications and other scientific information.
4. Collaboration and exchange of resources and staff in the area of library and other auxiliary services.
5. Other educational and academic exchanges to which both universities agree.

Article III: Financial Arrangement

1. Both parties agree that all specific arrangements and plans for activities are to be negotiated and are dependent on the availability of funds.
2. Both parties agree to seek financial support from national and international organizations for the cooperative activities to be undertaken as stated under the terms of this MOU.

Article IV: Agreement of Implementation

A detailed description of the scope of activities shall be defined in the Agreement of Implementation, which constitutes an integral part of this MOU.

The Agreement of Implementation will include such items as:

1. Elaboration of the responsibilities of each institution for the agreed upon activity.
2. Schedules for specific activities.
3. Budgets and sources of financing for each activity.
4. Any other items deemed necessary for the efficient management of the activity.

Article V: Intellectual Property Rights and Publication

1. The parties will share all data and research findings, patent rights, copyrights, and other intellectual property rights to any discoveries, inventions and products resulting from this MOU.
2. Both parties must give written approval for the utilization and publication of the data and research findings.
3. Detailed management of the Intellectual Property Rights and Publication shall be defined in the Agreement of Implementation of each activity.

Article VI: Settlement of Differences


The differing viewpoints and interpretations of this MOU shall be settled amicably by mutual consultation or negotiation.

Article VII: Amendments, Duration and Termination

1. Amendments to this MOU can only be written by mutual consent for the two parties.
2. This MoU shall be effective from the date of signature for a period of five (5) years with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving six (6) months notice to the other party in writing. It may be extended by mutual consent of the two institutions, or amended by the exchange letters. Such notice of termination will not interfere with cooperative programs currently underway. Such programs will be allowed to continue until their conclusion.


